COOKIE POLICY

This Cookie Policy refers to all Internet portals ("Portals"), whose operator is a limited liability company operating under Splentum limited liability company with registered office in Rzeszów, ul. Solarza 6/18, entered in the register of enterprises of the National Court Register (KRS) run by the District Court in Rzeszów, XII Economic Division, under KRS number 0000594413, NIP (Tax Identification Number) 8133710147, REGON (National Business Register Number) 362933748, e-mail address: kontakt@splentum.pl, especially MRSO.PL portal, available at the following address: www.mrso.pl and Splentum portal available at www.splentum.pl.

By entering the websites on the Portal the User ("User") allows to activate Cookie files on principles determined by this Policy. If the User does not express their consent to the use of Cookie files by the portal, they should change the settings of their browser or resign from using portal websites.

What are Cookie files?

By Cookie files we should understand IT data, especially text files, stored in User's end devices, dedicated to using Internet sites. These files allow to recognize the User's device and properly show the website tailored to their individual preferences. Cookie files usually contain the name of the website from which they come, the time of storing them on the end device and a unique number.

How Portals use Cookie files and how they use stored information?

Portals use two types of Cookie files:

- Session Cookies temporary Cookie files existing on the device only when staying at particular websites of the Portal, or, more precisely, until the User leaves such websites. They allow to remember the User's choices from the previous page.
- Regular Cookies Cookie files which remain on the User's device even after leaving the portal.
 They enable identification of a unique User by storing a randomly allocated number and allow the website to remember the previous settings when it is re-visited by the User, such as the choice of language in case of multi-language sessions.

Information on navigation on the website. Such Cookie files are used by Portals to collect vital information on movement on the website and the way the website is used by the User. Portals collect such data using Google Analytics tool.

Cookie files on Portals do not collect personal data which would enable personal identification of the User.

How to limit or delete Cookie files from the device?

Most Internet browsers have default settings automatically receiving Cookie files. The User may change the browser's settings in order to block Cookie files — completely or partly. Information on settings can be found in the help menu of a browser or in the User's Manual of a particular device. It should be remembered, though, that if we block or restrict the use of Cookie files, this may negatively affect the convenience of using the Portals.
